## Petition to the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan

We, the undersigned residents of The Province of Saskatchewan, wish to bring to your attention the following:

The Engineering firm of Stantec has submitted a proposal for a west bound passing lane on highway 16 in front of Freba Pottery and the heritage house of Marea Olafson/Brad Knight. The access road to the business Freba Pottery will be impacted with the present proposal. This business has two driveways for customers to come into the business and loop out back onto the highway making it easy for travellers to stop in the honour system highway store. Marea Olafson and Brad Knight have been advocating since learning of this proposal since May 2024. Freba Pottery has been operating for 11 years on the honour system and has become a Saskatchewan Tourism Destination for people all over the world. Having a passing lane in front of the business will create access roads to be changed and cause access to the store to be more difficult.

There are three scenarios put forward for approval from the Ministry of Highways.

- 1. Change driveway access to the Municipal Heritage Site to go North of the property and join to the grid to the west of the property and keep passing lane in front of the property
- 2. Relocate the present south bound grid road called Gudnason Road to the East to line up with the driveway of Freba Pottery and keep passing lane in front of the property
- 3. Shift the passing lane to the East of the property of Marea Olafson/ Brad Knight and Freba Pottery to end where the proposal has it set to start.

We, in prayer that reads as follows; respectfully request the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan ensure that the passing lane proposal is placed to the east of the property of Marea Olafson/Brad Knight and the business Freba Pottery to not impact the present access points to highway 16 of this property.
